Objectives

- The programme contributes to encouraging the entrepreneurial spirit and culture of innovation and also to offer support for modelling the ideas of researchers and PhD students in the energy efficiency sector.
- The programme helps researchers find new applications for their technologies by providing market solutions
- Collaborate with promoters of the energy sector, as business accelerators and investment funds (Fundació Repsol and InnoEnergy) in an attempt to consolidate projects.

Who is it designed for?

It is aimed at researchers, doctoral students, and companies who have a technology that is outstanding for its use of procedures or technologies that imply significant contributions to the areas of energy efficiency and savings. For example, projects based on:

- The development of new technologies, services, products and materials to promote the energy efficiency along the entire process: research, production, distribution, supply and use of energy.
- The development of innovative technologies for the storage and management of energy transport/distribution networks that ensure less energy consumption.
- Application of information technology designed to increase savings in consumption and improve energy efficiency.
- New materials for the energy and chemical industry: technologies associated with the obtaining high-performance materials for the energy and chemical industry.
- Recovery of energy from waste to encourage the development of an efficient circular economy.
- Mobility: innovative technologies and business models related to forms of disruptive mobility, both of people and of things; with management systems of big data and data science, and with algorithms for obtaining knowledge of deal.
- Smart buildings and cities

Results of the Programme

During development of the programme, participants will be provided with tools required to develop a three-year employment plan for their project, including timings, risks, resources, etc.

Price and Registration

People interested in participating in the programme must present an application using the form available on the web page. They will then be sent an e-mail confirming registration. Registration will be open until February 16th, 2018.

Participation in the Programme is free for all members of the UAB community and places are limited. On the other hand, Engega! will have a cost of 150 Euros for people interested in participating from outside the campus UAB.

Participation in the program must be in group. Minimum of two people and a maximum of five.
